

The main lodge is situated just beside a beautiful lake in the middle of the forest. It has a reception, restaurant for 80 people, bar, lounge and 10 double rooms upstairs. After activity we always have the hotel sauna heated, where you can relax and enjoy the beautiful view over the lake. Before dinner you can enjoy a drink in our lounge bar and then settle down in the restaurant for a good meal made with local ingredients from Lapland. The building next to the main Lodge has 7 double rooms, 1 northern lights apartment and a meeting room for 20-40 people. Downstairs you can also enjoy a cold beer or a cloudberry sour in our cozy Brown Bear Bar.



Guest Rooms

17 double rooms divided over the two main buildings. Classic and comfortable, with en suite facilities. In all rooms, the double beds can be divided into two single beds.



Northern Lights Apartment

Northern lights apartment, 4-6 persons, situated on the second floor with 2 double rooms, 1 lounge room with extra bed and 1 bathroom with toilet and shower. Both bedrooms have windows facing north, for northern lights viewing.



Cabins

3 cabins, 2-4 persons, with en suite facilities, 1 room with double bed, bed sofa and a fire stove to make a cozy fire in the evening after a day filled with winter adventures. Perfect option for couples.



Arctic Living Apartments

6 arctic living apartments, 4-6 persons, with en suite facilities, 2 bedrooms with double bed and a living room with bed sofa, fire stove and a fully equipped kitchen. Bathroom with shower and sauna, separate toilet. Suitable for 2 couples or a family.







Restaurant & Lounge

In the main building, the restaurant is where you can enjoy breakfast, lunch and dinner. We serve locally sourced food to give you a taste of all Lapland has to offer.



Brown Bear Bar

Join us in the cozy Brown Bear Bar for a locally brewed beer or a cloudberry cocktail. Enjoy a game of pool or dart and if you are feeling brave, grab the microphone for a few songs on karaoke night!



Aurora Hideaway

Once in a lifetime, sleep in our wooden Aurora Hideaway. Away from the lodge, but still in walking distance. The Hideaway is located in a great spot to watch the northern lights, and has 3 glass walls from floor to roof.



Sauna & Relax

Our indoor sauna is located in the main lodge and available for all guests to use before or after activities. Treat yourself to a private traditional sauna with ajoining outdor jacuzzi by the lake for total relaxation.



Wilderness Cabins

Up to 12 persons. (Used at overnight adventure tours). These cabins are traditional fishing and hunting cabins, which means no running water, outdoor toilet and a fire stove to heat the cabin. Shared facilities. Simple, but beautiful!





LANNAVAARA > LAPLAND






The lodge is situated in Lannavaara, 200 km north of the Arctic Circle, close to the mountains of Lapland. A great pristine wilderness with strong sapmi culture. This far north, the days are short and for a certain period the sun never rises above the horizon, also known as "Polar Nights" or "Kaamos".
